Installation

The printer driver supports the printer Océ Arizona 6170 XTS (6 colors)

Environment requirements are as follows: The driver is available for Windows and Mac OS X.

- Printer settings

The Océ Arizona 6170 XTS can be configured as a six-color (CMYKcm) printer.

- Output settings

The “Resolution” and “Print mode” settings are linked. Each time you select a different resolution, the possible print modes are displayed.

White printing

White adds another 100% of ink.

The settings for White ink are on the “Special Printer Settings” pane of the “Special” tab (System Manager and Job Explorer).
