#### Availability:

Fiery XF 6.2.1 is available as an online update for all configurations of Fiery XF and Fiery proServer running Fiery XF 6.2. Customers with 6.0 installed, first need to update to 6.1 (via the online updater, or using 6.1 DVDs) then use the online updater to 6.2, then to 6.2.1. Customers with an earlier version installed need to perform a full installation of 6.0 or 6.1, and then perform the online update(s) to get to 6.2.1. Fiery XF 6.1 for Jetrion is available only as a full installation, regardless of the currently installed version.
