

RELEASE NOTES

EFI™ is pleased to announce the release of Fiery® proServer and Fiery XF 7.0.3.

This latest release is free of charge for all users.

Bug fixes:

- Cutting-related fixes:
 - Fixed a Step and Repeat offset issue when using Summa® OPOS marks in conjunction with the Fiery Cut Server Option.
 - The EPSON® driver's Autocut feature is now set to On by default again (replacing the fix in 7.0.2 that did not work correctly in all scenarios).
- Printer-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue that would cause job labels to be truncated in nestings if Media Size Correction was used with EFI VUTEK® FabriVU printer drivers.
 - Fixed an issue that would prevent Media Suction to be enabled on the Epson SureColor SC-P7000.
 - Fixed an issue with job detail ink consumption values being displayed incorrectly for the EFI Pro 16h within Fiery Command WorkStation®.
 - Fixed an issue with ink consumption values not being correctly captured in the XML files of EFI Matan printer drivers.
 - Fixed print mode-related issues seen on HP DesignJet Z6100 / Z6200 / Z6800 printers.
 - Fixed an EFI Matan printer driver-related issue that would cause print mode names to always be displayed in capital letters.
 - Fixed a Roland DG VG-640 cmkW driver issue that would display "cancelling" on the printer panel when users attempted to print & cut.
 - Fixed a "number of copies" issue on the Roland DG EJ-640 driver, where the selected number of copies would not be honored.
 - Fixed an issue with the Sawgrass VJ-628 driver that would lead to a lack of smoothness in the yellow channel post the calibration, especially in the area of 0-20% ink coverage.
- PDF-related fixes:
 - Fixed an Adobe® PDF Print Engine issue that could prevent the Fiery XF server to start. This occurred if the user assigned a custom (non-system) account to the Fiery XF service — e.g. to gain access to remote hot folders — this caused an access issue in memory.
- TIFF-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue that would incorrectly show the error message "No media profile available" when users imported *.tiff files into a nesting.
- Fiery XF Universal Driver-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue that would cause Media Size and Media Profile selections not to be honored within the Fiery XF Universal Driver, unless other settings were also changed before saving.
 - Fixed an issue that would accidentally scale Zünd cut marks when the Fit to Width feature was enabled in the Fiery XF Universal Driver.

- FAST RIP-related issues:
 - Fixed a FAST RIP issue that would cause “empty lines” to appear in the printed output of PDF/X-1 files.
- Nesting-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue that would prevent large nestings creating a second sheet on EFI VUTEk printers.
- Job Editor-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue that caused ink consumption for cropped jobs to be displayed incorrectly.
 - Fixed an issue that would cause job labels to be truncated for RGB-based single jobs if Media Size Correction was used.
 - Fixed the display of the current server version in job labels, which was incorrectly shown as 7.0.1 in version 7.0.2.

- Fiery XF 7.0.3 is available as an online update via Fiery Server Control for all configurations of Fiery proServer and Fiery XF version 7. (Fiery XF 7.0.2 is a prerequisite for the installation of Fiery XF 7.0.3.)
